We are looking for a qualified Master's Level clinician with a licensed eligible (LPC or LCSW) degree or a Bachelor degree in Nursing (BSN) with five years of experience.

To provide weeknight, weekend and holiday emergency on-call services to individuals and concerned others experiencing psychiatric and substance abuse emergencies. Duties are to evaluate and intervene according to needs of the consumer and the severity of the crisis.

Extensive training will be provided as a Virginia Mandated Prescriber. The position involves face to face assessments of individual in crisis and determining the least restrictive treatment option.

The position will work closely with law enforcement, magistrates, private providers, hospital medical staff and other community stakeholders. You will be joining a team of Mental Health Professionals working to make a difference to those experiencing an emotional crisis.

Applicant must meet specific knowledge, skills and abilities in the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness, intellectual disabilities and substance abuse disorders. Computer skills are necessary.
