Counselor will also provide PATH (crisis stabilization and intervention) services, and may also provide mental health supports services to youth in the community as well.

Applicant must meet specified knowledge, skill and abilities requirements that include knowledge of serious mental illness, substance abuse, treatment modalities and intervention techniques, consumer's rights and community resources. Skills in client assessment, service planning and delivery, identifying and creating resources are needed. Ability to work independently and as a team member with effective oral and written communication skills is a must. Minimum education of a Bachelor's degree in human services and QMHP, or any combination of education and experience which meets, at minimum QMHP-e requirements.
